



# Volunteer Opportunities



People choose to volunteer for a variety of reasons. For some, it offers the chance to give something back to the community or make a difference to the people around them. <b>Ohio Tree Care Conference</b>	Work with this powerful committee that selects presenters and secures exhibitors and sponsors. Volunteers introduce session presenters and serve as room moderators during the conference.
<b>Proper Tree Planting</b>	As a tree care professional, you know that planting a tree the right way is important. Many have become complacent and just want to get it in the ground fast. This committee is focused on retraining planters, working with nursery growers, and educating faculty, including landscape architects.
<b>Research</b>	Do you use research to educate consumers or to justify your practices? Join this committee to identify research affecting Ohio arborists.
<b>Safety</b>	Volunteers identify training opportunities and coordinates Chapter events at the Ohio High School Landscape Olympics and the recreational climbing tree at the annual Ohio Tree Climbing Championship.
<b>Workforce Development</b>	It takes a village to develop the next generation of arborists. Join this team to help identify resources and opportunities to promote careers in arboriculture.
